PSIP CLAIM APPEALS

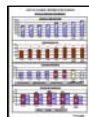
When appealing a claim, make sure all documents requested (i.e. op reports, path reports) are submitted with a HCFA/ CMS 1500, a CHIP form and a copy of the RA with the denial or reject letter. Appeal claims may be submitted via mail to American Insurance Administrators (AIA) (address listed under Billing Updates).

BILLING UPDATES

Providers submitting claims by mail should:

- ▶ Make sure print is clear and legible on the HCFA/CHIP forms
- ▶ No longer staple the HCFA/CMS and CHIP forms together. Submit one CHIP form with each HCFA
- ▶ Submit claims on an ongoing basis
- ▶ Submit all PSIP claims to AIA at:

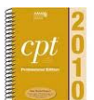

PHYSICIAN REIMBURSEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (PRAC)

The Physician Reimbursement Advisory Committee (PRAC) is an advisory committee to the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services on matters related to the reimbursement of emergency and trauma care to private sector physicians. The membership consists of emergency and other specialty physicians, surgeons and billing agents. This committee was established to make recommendations on policies, procedures and rates for the reimbursement of physicians and to review appeals of rejected or denied claims.

CONSULTATION CODES WILL NO LONGER BE PAID BY MEDICARE

Effective January 2010 service dates, Medicare does not cover Consultation Codes 99241-99255. As a result, effective FY 2010/11 PSIP will no longer pay for these codes. **Only existing visit codes 99201-99205 (Outpatient) and 99221-99223 (Inpatient) will be considered for payment.**
